

KIM VAUGHN - Sound



As the 2014 Lifetime Achievement Award winner, Kim Vaughn is one of the most recognizable women in the barbershop harmony world. She directed the San Diego Chorus, 2001 International Champions, for 30 years and is a Master Director 700. Kim is a Sound category judge and Master level International faculty.

Kim's talents lie not only in her directing and teaching skills, but also in her own performance accomplishments. She has won the coveted women's International quartet Champion title three times, the first woman to ever do so. She won her first title in 1976 with High Society, again in 1988 with Savvy and most recently in 2001 with A Cappella Gold.

Kim is a voice teacher who is active not only with her own studio and coaching around the barbershop world but is also a frequent contributor to online seminars concerning women's vocal issues in every style of music.

Ann Gooch is a Sweet Adeline International member for 50+ years, a certified music judge, an international faculty specialist emeritus, a past International President, and a recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award. Ann is widely known as the woman who put the "International" in Sweet Adelines having traveled the world educating and promoting barbershop harmony

and Sweet Adelines Worldwide.

BARBARA NIELSEN - Visual Communication



This is Barbara's 31st year of official panel service and her second visit to Albany, NY. She was also a frequent visitor to Region 15 when she was a judge candidate and trial scoring. A native Marylander, Barbara lives in Baltimore County and is retired from McCormick & Company (spices, herbs, food products) after 43 years of service. In fact, she now serves on

the McCormick Retiree Association Board of Directors and has edited their newsletter for a number of years. And she is a devoted fan of the Baltimore Orioles and Baltimore Ravens.

In her Sweet Adeline life, in addition to judging, she sings Tenor and serves as a Section Leader in the Harbor City Music Company Chorus, current 4^{th} Place International Medalist Chorus. Three of the biggest thrills in her Sweet Adeline life are being a part of the Elkridge "orphan package" . . . being onstage with Pride of Baltimore in their first international contest and placing 6^{th} . . . and being in the judging pit when Harbor City's own Lustre won their crowns.

When she is not singing, she is an avid book club member and gardener. She enjoys digging in the dirt in both her large backyard flowerbed and her community vegetable garden—where she grows one of the most delicious things in the world—a Maryland tomato! And, yes, they go great with steamed crabs!


