

Regional Most Improved Quartet Award

Eligibility for this award is open to any quartet that has no more than one new member. No minimum score is required. Quartets performing For Evaluation Only or in the Open Division are not eligible for this award. Quartets must have competed the previous year. There is no limit on the number of times a quartet can win this award.

As of 2024, medals for this award are being sponsored by our 2023 Most Improved Quartet, Repeat Offenders (Laura Packer, Sabrina Doolittle, Kiara Contreras, and Alexis DePersia-Norelli). They have designed a beautiful new medal along with a polka dot ribbon commemorating the costumes they wore when they won this award. The medals will be awarded along with the traditional traveling plague supplied by the region. Repeat Offenders' generous sponsorship will fund the Most Improved Quartet Award medals for many years to come. Alexis shared: "We decided to do this because we have always thought of this award as the pinnacle of regional quartet achievement. As Sweet Ads, we talk so much about how contest is a chance to get feedback on our own personal growth, and no award embodies that more for us than Most Improved Quartet. The winners of this award deserve to sport medals showing off their hard work."

Dody O'Brien Most Improved Chorus Award



This award was established in March 2006 in Memory of Dody O'Brien's years of dedicated service. She embodied a spirit of unfaltering trust in our organization's ability to inspire members to achieve goals of improved success through harmony.

Renee Craig Performance Award



This award was established in March 2007 by The Harmony Celebration Chorus to honor Renee Craig's accomplishments in both Region 15 and Sweet Adelines International. It was designed to recognize that, although the goal is always musical excellence, it is the performance that creates the magic. This award is given for the highest combined scores in Expression

and Visual Communication.

Harriette Walters Leadership Award



The Region 15 Management Team (RMT) established this award in 2010 to recognize the qualities that International Faculty Member and Greater Nassau Chorus Master Director 700 Harriette Walters demonstrates in every aspect of her Sweet Adelines life.

Here are some of the qualities the RMT weighs in the selection: trustworthiness, discipline, ability to identify great ideas, willingness to motivate and inspire, dedication to ongoing growth. Applications are accepted annually for this award through December 15, and they should be submitted to the region 15 Team Coordinator.

Audience Choice/ Bravo Award

The Audience Choice/Bravo Award was discontinued by Sweet Adelines International and cannot be presented on the contest stage. It has been reinstated by Greater NY/NJ Region 15 and will be presented during the Regional Awards presentation following the competition.

Region 15 sponsors the chorus award and Monkey Wrench Quartet sponsors the quartet award. Both awards are for open division competitors only and will be chosen by audience ballots if two or more quartets/choruses are competing. To be eligible for this award a quartet or chorus must achieve a score of C or better.
