

International front: If you haven't already heard, Region 15's Sky Harris (2015 NAfME winner, Assistant Director for Spirit of Syracuse and Region 15's Co-Youth



Coordinator) has just been selected by the International Board of Directors as one of three coordinators for the international Young Women in Harmony Program! Sky is a fabulous choice for this position, and will be working in concert with Amy Leacock and Natalie Allen. Please join me in congratulating her on this most prestigious appointment!

On another, completely different international topic: As some of you may know, the International Board has proposed a major change in leadership and structure of all regional management teams. The Regional Governance *Proposal* has been presented by a task force which was convened at the International level. The proposal is available for all members to review on the MEMBERS ONLY side of SAI's website. I encourage each of you to review it - if passed this proposal will take all Regional Management Teams from their current 8 members down to three, who will act as executive directors for the region. Region 15's Management Team has spent many hours reviewing and digesting the information that has been provided to us; in Mid-April each RMT will cast a single vote either for or against the proposal. The outcome of this world-wide vote will affect every Regional Management Team, and ultimately, every member of Sweet Adelines. I encourage you to familiarize yourself with the proposal; we will not know the outcome until after May 1st, at which time the RMT will communicate directly with regional chorus leaders regarding the result and its impact on this region.

In the meantime, your RMT continues to work hard for you by developing a long-range plan for education, membership and recruitment, and fiscal stability. Our contact information is listed on Region 15's website, and we're always appreciative of a word of encouragement, or advice. If you need us, we're available!


Fulton, Choruses were asked to have one consistent marketing message.

prospective members to "Give the Gift of Harmony" this season.






