

CHORUS MEMBERSHIP & MARKETING!

When you think of "marketing" your chorus, consider not only what message you want to share, but who your audience might be. The first question to ask is "Who are we?" then consider, "Who do we want to talk to?" and then "How can we talk to them?" If you are looking for someone who likes to cook, the best place to look is in the kitchen, right? You could yell in the middle of the street and hope that people who like to cook hear you, but it would be easy and more efficient if you put a flyer in every kitchen you can find or in a local culinary school newsletter. It is the same with marketing to potential members. Is it better to put a flyer up in a supermarket (a general place like yelling in the street) or could you consider sending a flyer addressed to the chorus of your local church or to the members of a local college choral group?
